New Hope Christian Counselling is looking for a new leader who will build on the success of the charity's first ten years, as led by its visionary and dedicated founder. The role involves building good working relationships with the trustees, staff and community to ensure the strength, development and sustainability of the charity into the future.

The role will include leading with good decisions to support the operational pillars of counselling, management and finance, whilst advancing the Christian values of the Charity and its mission statement. The new leader will be responsible for the efficient running of the service, which offers online and in person counselling, by professionally qualified counsellors and appropriately trained students in their placement periods. The charity has a number of paid workers all of whom make further contributions on a voluntary basis. There is flexibility for the successful candidate to define the aspects of the role that they feel match both their vision for New Hope and their own skill set. We will consider further recruitment to complete the coverage of necessary responsibilities.

Last Year, New Hope responded successfully to the COVID pandemic and developed an online service, which is continuing. The charity offered sessions to 280 clients, working from three centres in Stratford, Kenilworth and Warwick. Our work is supported by local churches. New Hope has historically relied on donations and grants for financial income but are now starting to charge for some more specialist counselling services.
